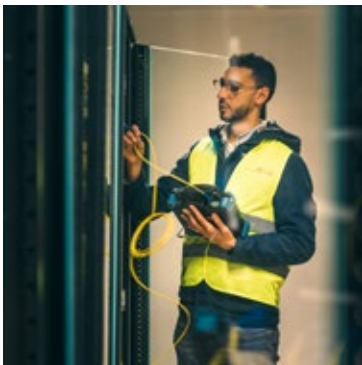
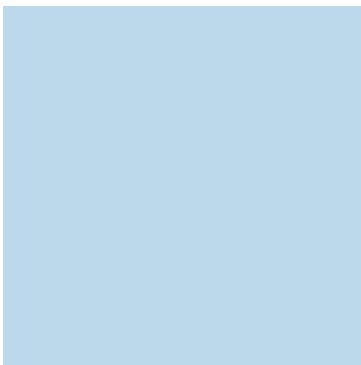
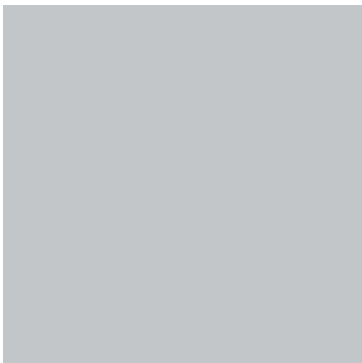

ABOUT US

Tanger Med Group operates and develops ports, logistics and industrial platforms. It manages Tanger Med port complex, the leading port in the Mediterranean and Africa. Through «Marsa Maroc», it also manages 35 container and bulk terminals across 21 ports. The total volume handled by the Group is 209 million tons of goods and 12.42 million TEUs.

The Group is also the planner and developer of more than 3 000 hectares of economic activity zones which host more than 1500 companies and generate a business volume of 20.61 billion dollars in the automotive, aeronautics, textile, agribusiness and logistics sectors.

OUR KEY MILESTONES



2003

In 2003, under the leadership of His Majesty King Mohammed VI, began the story of one of the Kingdom's largest economic projects and the foundation of our Group, marked by the launch of construction works for Tanger Med Port 1.



2007

Four years later, in 2007, His Majesty King Mohammed VI inaugurated Tanger Med Port 1, commissioning the first container terminal of the port complex.



2009

In 2009, His Majesty King Mohammed VI launched Tanger Med's Industrial Platform, which was integrated into the port complex to create a competitive ecosystem.



2010

In 2010, His Majesty King Mohammed VI inaugurated the Passenger and Trucks Port, aimed at enhancing passenger capacity while supporting the development of Moroccan exporters and importers.



2012

In 2012, His Majesty King Mohammed VI inaugurated the Renault Tanger Med plant, the largest automotive production facility in Africa. That same year saw the launch of "Tanger Automotive City" economic zone to support the establishment of Renault suppliers, as well as the launch of "Tetouan Shore," dedicated to offshoring services.



2014

In 2014, His Majesty King Mohammed VI inaugurated Tanger Med Port Center and launched construction works for the Export Access infrastructure.



2022

In 2022, the industrial platform surpassed 1,200 active companies, while the Group reached a total throughput of over 150 million tons.



2021

In 2021, the Group began a new strategic chapter by partnering with Marsa Maroc, the national leader in port terminal operations, present in 9 other ports across the Kingdom, in addition to Tanger Med. In the same year, the TC3 container terminal at Tanger Med Port began commercial operations.



2020

In 2020, the port complex became the number one container port in the Mediterranean and confirmed its position as the African leader for the fourth consecutive year.



2019

In 2019, His Royal Highness Crown Prince Moulay El Hassan represented His Majesty King Mohammed VI at the launch of port operations at Tanger Med Port 2. The port complex thus became the leading port capacity in the Mediterranean.



2017

In 2017, Tanger Med Port, a concrete achievement of His Majesty King Mohammed VI's vision, celebrated 10 years of operational activity.



2016

In 2016, Tanger Med Group signed the concession agreement for the TC4 terminal of Tanger Med Port 2 with global operator APM Terminals. This new concession reaffirmed APM Terminals' commitment to making Tanger Med its main logistics hub in the region.



2023

In 2023, the port complex handled 8.6 million containers, representing 95% of its nominal capacity, a result achieved four years ahead of schedule.



2024

In 2024, the port complex surpassed the milestone of 10 million containers and 500,000 trucks. Marsa Maroc secured the management of Terminals 1 and 5 of the Port of Cotonou in Benin.



2025

In 2025, the port complex surpasses the 11 million containers mark. Marsa Maroc acquires a stake in Boluda Maritime Terminals (BMT).

Industry

Planning and development of over 3,000 hectares of industrial parks, home to 1,500 companies in sectors such as automotive, aerospace, textiles, agri-food, electronics, and logistics.



Services

Complementary service offerings focused on technology, engineering, and utilities to support the needs of operators established in Tanger Med's Industrial Platform.

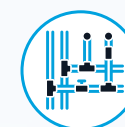

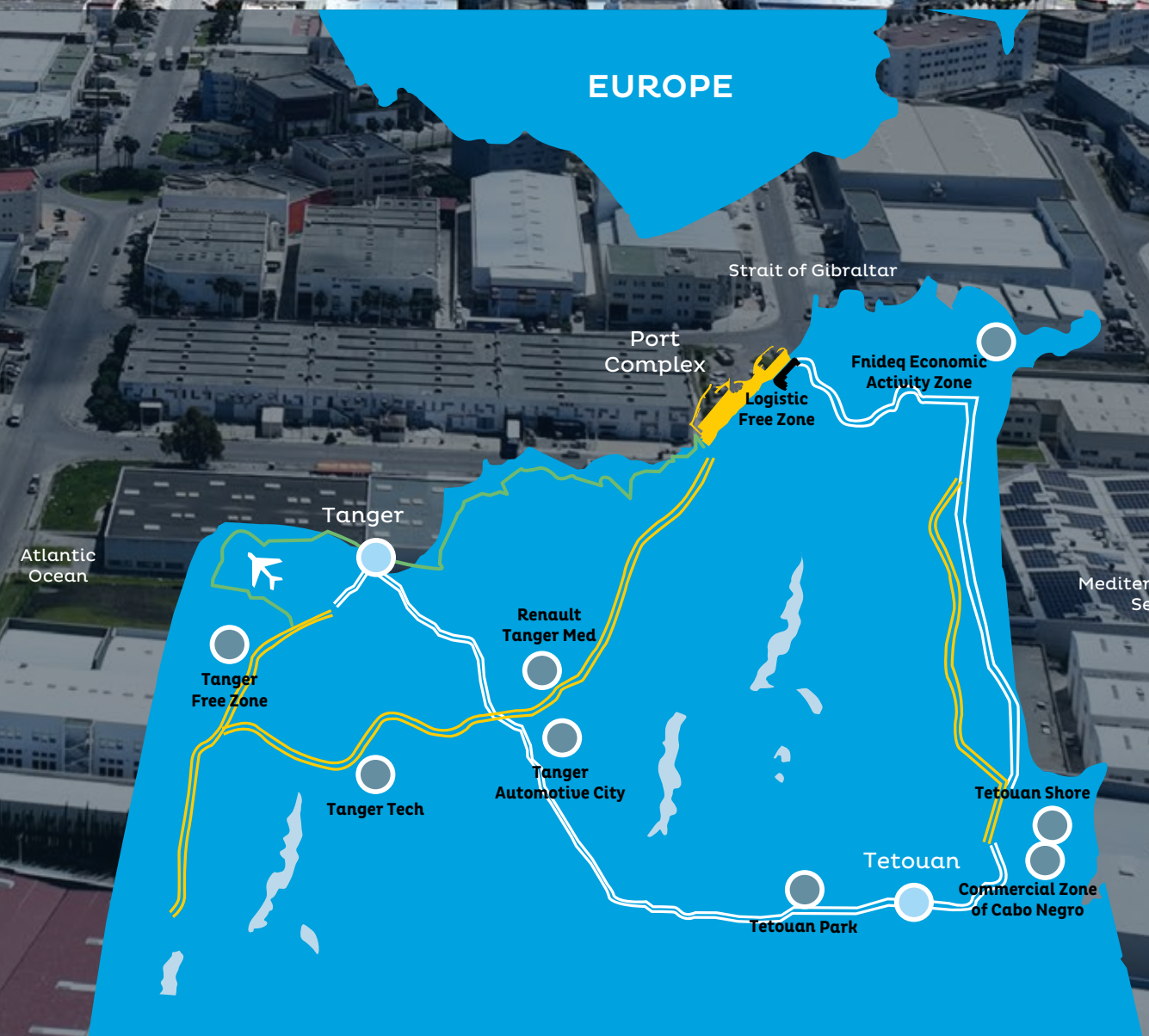
